- 4. Some government information suggests that volunteering helps to build a sense of local community and gives volunteers a greater sense of personal worth. What are some more benefits to volunteering that you can list? (elaboration)
- 5. Why does volunteering appeal to some but not to others? (complexity)
- 6. How does volunteering make our community a better place? (curiosity)
- Imagine that everyone in our society volunteered 4 hours per week, what could we do with all of that volunteer energy and labour? (imagination)
- 8. How could you volunteer 2 hours per week even while being a student (risk taking)?
