or
‘AFL football matches should (or should not) be played on Good Friday’
or
‘Easter has become too commercialised’.
6. List ten different ways you could eat an Easter egg.
7. Give three possible explanations for the association of rabbits with Easter eggs.
8. The answer is Easter. What are the questions?
9. List attributes of both and then combine
an Easter egg
AND
a kite.
10. Find common points between the celebrations of Easter and Christmas.
